OFY-SJ will accept quotes covering all or any portion of the services. Please ensure your quote clearly indicates which services are included in the quote. OFY-SJ reserves the right to negotiate the final terms and conditions of the contract, including the scope of work.

Scope of Work

Seeking vendors to lead and facilitate a yearlong college readiness program with a group of selected high schools students.

- 1. Program staff should be able to:
 - a. To run various college readiness workshops throughout the year college applications, FAFSA, resume writing, EOP applications, etc.
 - b. To meet with student cohort regularly and be available to also meet with various students based on their college needs.
 - c. To host a parent/student pre-program orientation (including make-up orientation), assist with gathering all necessary paperwork, liaison with school to ensure all logistics are met all year long.
 - d. Demonstrate that they are CPR/First Aid trained, as well as trained in all emergency protocols.
 - e. To facilitate all provided curriculum, tutor throughout the year and support with grading.
 - f. To offer assistance once students graduate and enter college
- 2. Work with curriculum department to ensure students receive elective course credits
 - a. Curriculum should include:
 - i. Group discussion/activities
 - ii. Solo time focusing on being open to new experiences, observations, overcoming obstacles/solutions
 - iii. College readiness/preparation skills.
- 3. Customized program (including specific colleges and universities tours) and available additional services to enhance the program.
